The geographical center has moved ۴۲۳ kilometers north from the French town of Saint-Clement, where it lay in the years after the last great expansion of the community. "It is like winning the big prize without knowing you have bought a ticket," says Jean-Marc Delizee, who presents the area in Parliament.
